They also enter data electronically to process transactions, payments, denials and adjustments. Completing Workers Compensation claims and collection of unpaid accounts is another responbility of these professionals HCE's also analyze and code procedures and diagnoses using ICD-10 CM & PCS, CPT and HCPCS coding.
