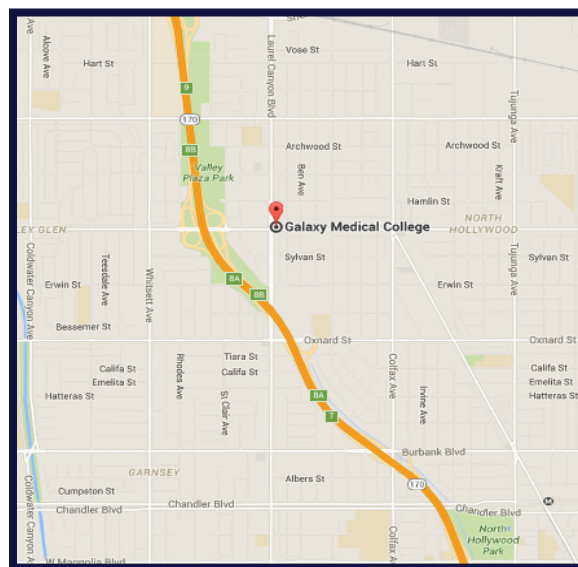

Medical Assistant

Medical Assistants perform administrative and clinical duties. Administrative duties include scheduling appointments and filing medical records, while clinical duties include recording vital signs, and assisting the physician during examinations.



Health Claims Examiner

Health Claims Examiners enter data electronically to process transactions, review and verify patient information, follow up on balances due, and prepare invoices. They also analyze and code surgical procedures and diagnoses using ICD-10 & CPT codes.



Pharmacy Technician

Pharmacy Technicians receive prescriptions and must verify information and prepare medications. Additionally, they maintain patient profiles, prepare insurance claim forms, and inventory all medications.



Phlebotomy Technician I

Phlebotomy Technicians perform a variety of blood collection methods using proper techniques and standard precautions. The program is taught through didactic, student laboratory and clinical experiences.
